


String System

Over the last 60 years it has evolved from being a ground-breaking concept to becoming one of the most loved pieces of classic Scandinavian design, being a favorite of both designers and architects. The measurements are fixed and have never been altered since they were first designed and marketed. The shelves can always be rebuilt, redesigned and transformed to a customer's specifications
