

## Norman Bel Geddes American Art Deco Bedroom Set

Description

This three pieces bedroom set was designed by Norman Bel Geddes (1893 - 1958) for the Simmons Company of Chicago, Illinois. The line was introduced in 1932 and exhibited at the 1933 Worlds Fair in Chicago. The set is in "exhibition yellow" and black enamel on steel. The dresser is 36" high, 46  $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide and 19" deep. The headboard is 36" high and 52" wide, the curved footboard is 23" high and 53" wide.
